Progress of Work of the Committee on Home-School Cooperation

Background

The Committee on Home-School Cooperation (CHSC) was set up in 1993 to foster home-school cooperation and promote parent education. One of the CHSC's major tasks is to encourage and help schools to set up its Parent-Teacher Associations (PTAs). To date, over 90% of the government and aided schools have formed PTAs and Federations of Parent-Teacher Associations (FPTAs) have also been established in 17 districts.

Work of PTAs / FPTAs / CHSC

2. The main purpose of setting up PTAs is to promote home-school cooperation. The PTAs act as a bridge between parents and teachers to foster communication, understanding and mutual support.

3. At school level, PTAs organise different school-based home-school cooperation activities, parent-student activities and parent education programmes. They also offer voluntary service to assist schools in various ways, such as, inviting parents to serve as "Reading Parents", assisting in meal arrangements, school functions and fund-raising activities.

4. At district level, self-initiated FPTAs are formed by PTAs of the same district joining forces to achieve common goals. The FPTAs, build on their established district network, organise a large variety of learning activities, such as district-based tours of primary and secondary schools for parents, theme-based parent talks and seminars, as well as parent education programmes.

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5. At the territory level, the CHSC promotes positive attitudes towards home-school cooperation and parent education through publicity programmes, sharing of good practices, workshops and seminars. It supports the activities of PTAs and FPTAs by allocating project grants, developing training materials, publicising the values of home-school cooperation and encouraging harmonious family relationship.

6. Each year, the CHSC will identify a focus area of work. In the 2007/08 school year, it aims at promoting the concept of healthy family; and enhancing parent education with emphasis on the core values and the role of parents.

7. Over the years, a variety of initiatives have been introduced by the CHSC to strengthen home-school cooperation. These include the Primary and Secondary School Profiles published annually for parents' reference, seminars and annual symposiums, and weekly radio programmes on parenting (please refer to the Annex for the list of events launched / scheduled to be launched by the CHSC in the 2007/08 school year).

8. From 2003 to 2008, funding provided to the CHSC, PTAs and FPTAs has increased from \$16 million to \$23 million. In the 2006/07 school year, the number of home-school cooperation activities / parent education programmes launched by CHSC, PTAs and FPTAs amounted to about 2 500.

Challenges Encountered

9. While the activities launched by the CHSC, PTAs and FPTAs have a relatively large catchment of parents, there still remains a certain group of needy or underprivileged students whose families / parents are hard to reach. The concerted efforts of various sectors, such as the health and welfare sectors, are required to resolve their problems.

10. Families of different socio-economic background have specific concerns in the education of their children and thus require different levels and types of parent education. The rapid changes in economic development in recent years have further intensified the differences among families' social and economic conditions. This has called for parent education programmes that can better cater for the diversified needs of parents.

11. There is also an increasing call for early identification of families / parents who are in need of assistance so that timely support and intervention can be provided.

Way Forward

12. The CHSC will continue to collaborate with PTAs and FPTAs to step up parent education and relevant activities at the school, district and community levels to cater for the diversified needs of parents and to foster sustainable home-school cooperation.

13. To disseminate the positive values on the concept of healthy family, the CHSC will collaborate with various sectors of the community, especially the health and social service sectors. Cross-sectoral seminars and talks will be organized to promote understanding, and strengthen the cohesion and sense of belonging among family members. The PTAs, FPTAs and CHSC will be further encouraged to conduct activities at the school, district and territory levels to promote positive family values.

14. In short, a holistic approach with cross-sector efforts to enhance parent education will not only facilitate effective learning and healthy growth of our children, but also help achieve social cohesion and reinforce family harmony.
