Results of the Hong Kong Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Epidemiologic Survey: Age 6 to 17

PURPOSE

This paper briefs Members on the results of The Hong Kong Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Epidemiologic Survey: Age 6 to 17 (the "Survey").

BACKGROUND

- 2. The Health Bureau commissioned The Chinese University of Hong Kong to conduct the Survey from September 2019 to June 2023. The Survey aims to estimate the prevalence of 11 major categories of DSM-5¹ child and adolescent psychiatric disorders in a representative sample of 6 084 randomly selected children and adolescents (including non-ethnic Chinese) aged 6-17 years in Hong Kong.
